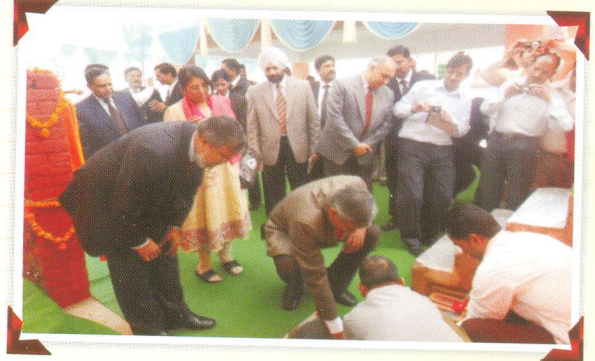

## MEDIATION CENTRE/ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION MECHANISM IN THE STATE

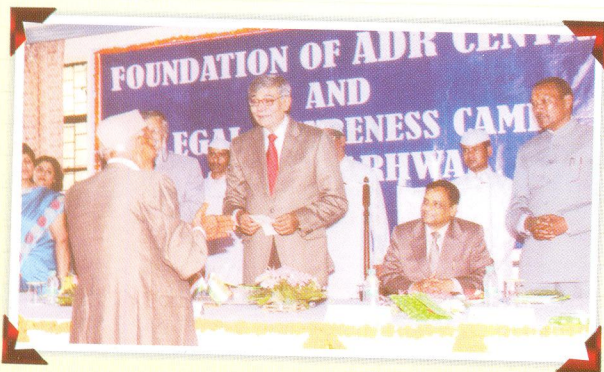
In order to provide legal aid and services and to conduct mediation, conciliation, arbitration and Lok Adalats activities under one roof, ADR Centres are being established in the State of Uttarakhand. In this drive, on 22.9.2012 foundation stone of ADR Centre at Tehri Garhwal was laid by the kind hands of Hon'ble Mr. Justice Barin Ghosh, The Chief Justice/Patron-In-Chief, Uttarakhand SLSA in the presence of Hon'ble Mr. Justice Tarun Agarwala, Hon'ble Executive Chairman, Uttarakhand SLSA, Registrar General of the High Court, District Judge Sri Kanta Prasad, Member Secretary, Uttarakhand State Legal Services Authority, Judicial Officers, Advocates and Administrative Officers.



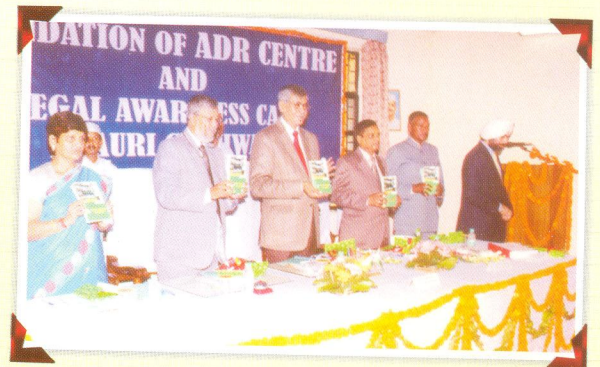
On 23.9.2012 foundation stone of ADR Centres at Pauri Garhwal was also laid by the kind hands of Hon'ble Mr. Justice Barin Ghosh, The Chief Justice/Patron-In-Chief, Uttarakhand SLSA in the presence of Hon'ble Mr. Justice Tarun Agarwala, Hon'ble Executive Chairman, Uttarakhand SLSA and Hon'ble Mr. Justice Sarvesh Kumar Gupta, Hon'ble Administrative Judge, Pauri.



The Registrar General of the High Court, Km. Kum Kum Rani, District Judge, Pauri, Member Secretary, Uttarakhand SLSA, Judicial Officers, officers of district administration, Advocates and public at large were present.



During the occasion, gathering was informed that the ADR Centres shall play a vital role in speedy disposal of long pending cases and they were also informed about the importance and benefits of mediation. Apart from this Nukkad drama was also presented by the "Navankur Natya Group" wherein focus was made on the settlement of disputes through mediation and other ADR mechanisms.



Keeping in view the considerable pendency of cases directions have been issued by Hon'ble the Patron-in-Chief for establishment of Mediation Centres at nine outlying Courts of Vikasnagar, Rishikesh, Roorkee, Laksar, Kotdwar, Kashipur, Khatima, Ramnagar and Haldwani of the State.

## MEGA LOK ADALATS, LOK ADALATS & LEGAL LITERACY/LEGAL AID CAMPS

Under the valuable guidance of Hon'ble the Patron-in-Chief and Hon'ble the Executive Chairman, Uttarakhand State Legal Services Authority, Mega Lok Adalats as well as monthly Lok Adalats in all the 13 districts of the State, under the aegis of all the District Legal Services Authorities, are being organized.

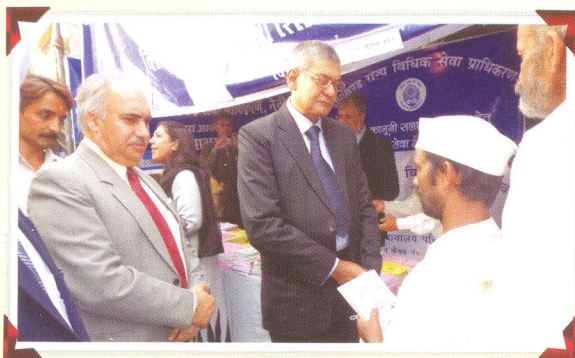
In the Mega Lok Adalats held between the months of July 2012 to September 2012 in all the 13 districts, the matters relating to MACT cases, Matrimonial cases, Revenue cases, Excise cases and cases relating to N.I. Act etc. were taken up. In these Mega Lok Adalats, a total number of 3346 cases of various nature were decided. A sum of Rs. 85,95,059/- was awarded as compensation to the victims of Motor Accident and fine to the tune of Rs. 34,65,565/- was realized towards petty offences, wherein a total number of 3505 persons were benefited.

In the Lok Adalats held in the months of July, August and September 2012 in all the 13 districts, a total number of 3959 cases were settled and a sum of Rs. 54,91,470/- was awarded as compensation and a fine to the tune of Rs. 23,05,401/- was realized. In the said Lok Adalats, 4267 persons were benefited.

In addition to this, a total number of 49 legal literacy camps were organized in all the 13 Districts of the State during July to September 2012 and 46206 persons were benefited in the said camps. In these camps, people were made aware about the aim of legal literacy camps, free legal aid and they were also informed about the general laws such as criminal law, revenue law, right to information act, right to education and law relating to protection of women, children etc.

## ACTIVITIES ON LEGAL LITERACY AND AWARENESS

In order to propagate legal awareness and to make the public aware about the legal aid services and activities of National, State and District Legal Services Authorities, the



Uttarakhand State Legal Services Authority had put up a stall during the 'Harela Mela' from 16.7.2012 to 21.7.2012. All the Hon'ble Judges of the High Court of Uttarakhand, including Hon'ble the Chief Justice/Patron-in-Chief, SLSA and Hon'ble the Executive Chairman, SLSA visited the stall in the said Mela. A total number of 1264 persons visited the stall and a total number of 11637 sets of booklets (34 booklets in one set) were distributed to the public.

The Uttarakhand State Legal Services Authority and District Legal Services Authority, Nainital in coordination with a charitable organization, namely Nishakt Jan Sewa Sansthan Pilibhit, organized one day legal literacy camp & free eye checkup and artificial limb registration camp on 29.7.2012 in the compound of New Club, Nainital. In the said camp, Member Secretary, Uttarakhand SLSA, Registrar (Judicial), Registrar (Protocol), District Judge-Nainital, other Judicial Officers of the Nainital Judgeship, President, District Bar Association, Nainital, Advocates and Administrative Officer participated. The camp was attended by school children, ladies, people from villages, senior citizens and handicap persons. The gathering was informed about the object of the Legal Services Authorities, schemes and Lok Adalat and they were also made aware about general laws, such as Mediation, Negotiable Instrument Act, Motor Vehicle Act, Women Rights, Labour Laws, PNDA Act etc. On the other hand, Nishakt Jan Sewa Sansthan, Pilibhit organized a free eye checkup and artificial limb registration camp wherein eye checkup of 200 persons was made and the people were also distributed medicines and spectacles free of cost. Free registration for artificial limb was also done. Artificial limbs have been provided to the handicap persons in a camp held by Nishakt Jan Sewa Sansthan at Pilibhit.

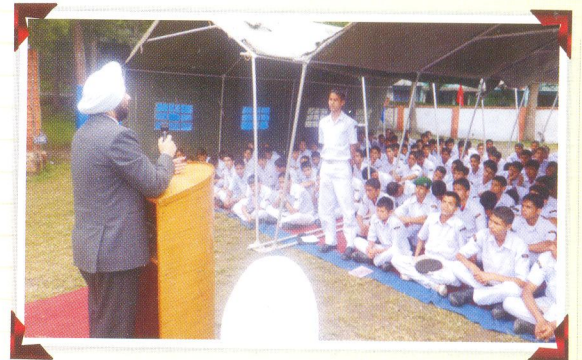


A three days legal literacy camp from 1.8.2012 to 3.8.2012 in the compound of the Varahi Devi temple of Devidhura, District-Champawat was organized. In the aforesaid camp, Hon'ble the Executive Chairman, UKSLSA, and Hon'ble Mr. Justice B.S. Verma, Judge, High Court of Uttarakhand made their benign presence. Member Secretary, Uttarakhand SLSA along with Registrars of the Hon'ble High Court, District Judge-Champawat, other Judicial Officers of the Champawat Judgeship, President, District Bar Association, Champawat and Advocates also participated in the camp on 2.8.2012. The camp was attended by large number of children, ladies, senior citizens and people from villages and other States as well. Hon'ble the Executive Chairman informed the gathering about the aims and objects of the Legal Services Authorities. People were also asked to approach the Legal Services Authorities for redressal of their grievances. Hon'ble Mr. Justice B.S. Verma, Judge, High Court of Uttarakhand told the public that they must be aware about their legal rights and duties and also informed about the services which may be availed by approaching the Legal Services Authorities. District Judge, Champawat also made the public aware about the legal awareness and legal aid activities being conducted by the



District Legal Services Authority, Champawat. People made queries on several issues and also sought information of various legal issues. The queries were answered and information was provided to the public. During the camp, 400 sets (34 books in a set, total 13,600 books) of informative material booklets namely, 'Saral Kanooni Gyan Mala' were also distributed free of cost to the public.

The Uttarakhand State Legal Services Authority, Nainital in coordination with National Cadet Corps, took an initiative by organizing one day Legal Literacy & Sensitization Camp on 14.09.2012 at Ratighat, District-Nainital, on the eve of Annual Training Programme by the Naval Unit, National Cadet Corps, Nainital. In the said camp, Sri Kuldeep Singh Dhillon, Capt. (IN), Commanding Officer, Naval Unit, National Cadet Corps, Nainital and about 250 cadets were present. The said camp was presided by Sri Kanwar Amninder Singh, Member Secretary, Uttarakhand State Legal Services Authority, Nainital. The Cadets were informed about Legal Services mechanism and legal aid, legal literacy and awareness activities being conducted by Legal Services Authorities and were also apprised of the basic laws. In making the people aware about their legal rights and in providing the social justice to the common masses, need of the coordination between Legal Services Authorities and the National Cadet Corps was also highlighted. On the said occasion, queries were made by the cadets on several subjects and they were informed in simple language. The National Cadet Corps has also ensured that the legal literacy and awareness as a subject shall be included in these types of training programmes. An emphasis has been made on organizing such types of camps regularly, so that the services of NCC Cadets may be used in sensitizing the society about their legal rights and social justice may be done. On the said occasion, 5000 legal informative booklets i.e. Saral Kanooni Gyan Mala were distributed to the cadets.

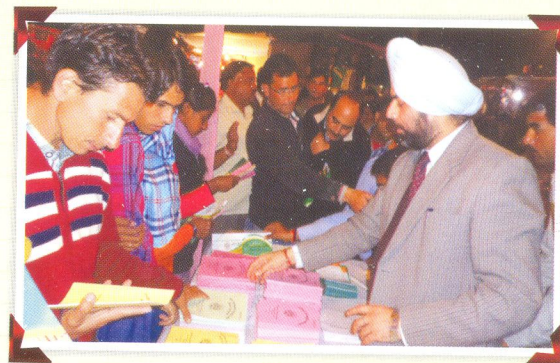


Apart from this, Uttarakhand State Legal Services Authority in coordination with High Court Legal Services Committee and District Legal Services Authority, Nainital installed a stall at Flat Ground, Nainital, District-Nainital from 22.9.2012 to 27.9.2012 so as to spread legal awareness, to make the public aware about the legal aid activities of the Legal Services Authorities and to sensitize them about their legal rights. Hon'ble the Chief Justice/Patron-in-Chief, Uttarakhand SLISA, Hon'ble Executive Chairman, Uttarakhand SLISA and Hon'ble Chairman, High Court Legal Services Committee and other Judges along with their respected spouses graced the occasion by their benign presence at the stall on 25.9.2012. Hon'ble the Chief Justice/Patron-in-Chief, SLISA distributed the sets of booklets namely 'Saral Kanooni Gyan Mala' to the persons visited the stall and the people were informed about the importance of the said booklets, as they provide basic information about various subjects of law. Member Secretary,



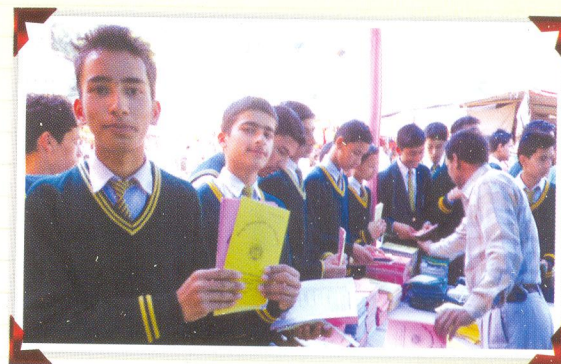
Registrars of the High Court, other Judicial Officers of Nainital Judgship and the Panel Lawyers from District Court, Nainital were also present at the stall.

The persons who visited the stall belonged to all stratas of the society. They were ladies, children, young students and old persons. During their visit at the stall people used to ask various questions and were informed about their problems for which they were given the legal awareness booklets and were also guided and informed about remedies.



During the aforesaid 'Nandastami Mela', a total number of 4500 persons visited the stall and a total number of 1,53,000 booklets including pamphlets and brochures were distributed to the public.

On 29.9.2012 District Legal Services Authority, Almora organized a micro legal literacy camp at Government Inter College, Syalidhar wherein students were informed about right to information, F.I.R. and other criminal offences, free education being provided by the Government as well as of their legal rights.



The District Legal Services Authority, Bageshwar organized a legal literacy camp on 2.9.2012 at Junior High School, Bhandola, Tehsil-Kanda wherein District Judge, Bageshwar made emphasis on the need of legal awareness. Gathering was informed about the laws relating to forest, juvenile and women and they were also appraised of the free legal services being provided by the legal services authorities.

On 14.9.2012 a legal literacy camp was organized by District legal Services Authority, Champawat at Government Inter College, Lohaghat wherein students were informed about laws relating to Ragging, Environment and Forest etc. Besides this, camps were also organized at P.G. College Champawat and Lohaghat under National Social Service Programme.

On 24.9.2012 District Legal Services Authority, Dehradun organized a legal literacy camps at Indira Nagar, Rishikesh wherein villagers of Indira Nagar, Gram Pradhan, residents of rehabilitated colony of Tehri Dam, public representatives and advocates were present. In the said camp objects of the legal services authorities were highlighted and people were informed that how can they settled their disputes and cases through the mediation centres as well as lok adalats. On 21.9.2012 a legal literacy camp was organized at Varni Jain Inter College, Dehradun wherein students were appraised of the objects and functions of the legal services authorities. They were also provided information on the basic legal subjects such as F.I.R., Compensation, M.A.C.T., Pre-litigation, Lok Adalats etc.

The District Legal Services Authority, Haridwar organized two legal literacy and sensitization camps at Primary School, Village-Aaneki and Primary School, Village-Belda. In the said camps people were informed about the laws relating to Right to Information, Revenue and Consumer Forum. They were also appraised of the Lok Adalat, Mediation Centre and legal aid being provided by the legal services authority.

The District Legal Services Authority, Nainital took an initiative by conducting a legal literacy class at Shahid Sainik School on 24.7.2012. In the said class, teachers and students were informed about basic laws relating to Child Marriage, M.A.C.T., Anti Ragging, Environment. Apart from this on 18.8.2012, 27.8.2012 and 31.8.2012 legal literacy camps were organized at Government Inter Colleges, Ramnagar and Jeolikot.

The District Legal Services Authority Pauri Garhwal in coordination with medical department organized a legal literacy and medical camp on 8.7.2012 at Government Inter College, Kanskhet. In the said camps judicial officers, advocates, officers of district administration and the public at large were present. People were informed about the basic laws so that they may be well aware about their legal rights. In the said camp free check-ups were made of the needy persons and they were provided medicines free of cost.

On 11.8.2012 District legal Services Authority, Pithoragarh organized a camp at Saraswati Dev Singh Government Inter College. In the said camp basic information as regards Child Labour (Prohibition) Act, Right to Education, Juvenile Justice and disadvantages of Ragging was given to the students. On 23.9.2012 District Legal Services Authority, Pithoragarh in coordination with several departments of the State Government, organized a legal literacy & medical camp at Block Office-Dharchula. In the said camp people were informed about several basic laws as well as of their legal rights. Free check-ups of patients were conducted and they were provided medicines. In the said camp disability certificates, Income certificates and copy of family register were also issued to the beneficiaries.

On 29.7.2012 District Legal Services Authority, Rudraprayag organized a legal awareness camp at Police Line-Ratuda wherein information relating to investigation, F.I.R., arrest, dowry homicide has been provided to the police personnel. On 16.9.2012 District legal Services Authority, Rudraprayag organized a legal literacy and awareness camp at Government Intermediate College, Rudraprayag. In the said camp students were informed about several laws relating to cyber crime, right to education, M.A.C.T. etc.

The District Legal Services Authority, Tehri Garhwal organized a legal literacy and sensitization camp on the subject of Female Foeticide at Government Girls Inter College, Burari on 14.7.2011. In the said camp judicial officers, advocates, officers of district administration, principles, teachers, students and other persons were present. In the said camp need of the social awareness to eradicate the female foeticide was expressed.

On 15.8.2012 District Legal Services Authority, Uttarkashi organized a special sensitization camp for the victims of flood at Urja Colony, Gangori. In the said camp people were informed about the schemes framed by the State Government for relief and rehabilitation. They were also informed about their legal rights. It is stated that the relief activities being carried out in the State for the disaster victims are having various defects. The said issue has been taken seriously. The matter has been referred to State Government and the reply of State Government is awaited.

The District Legal Services Authority, Udham Singh Nagar on 6.9.2012 organized a legal literacy camp at Chanakya Law College, Rudrapur wherein law students were informed about several laws, including the laws relating to woman and child protection.
