APPOINTMENT OF MEMBER SECRETARY AND OFFICER ON SPECIAL DUTY

Vide notification No. 85/XXXVI(1)/2015-184/2001-T.C.-IV dated 31.3.2015 issued by Government of Uttarakhand, Sh. Prashant Joshi in the rank of District & Sessions Judge has taken over the charge of office of Uttarakhand State Legal Services Authority as Member Secretary on 17.4.2015.

Sh. Mithilesh Jha in the rank of Civil Judge (Senior Division) has taken over the charge as Officer on Special Duty on 17.4.2015 in pursuance of the Notification No. 104/XXXVI(1)/2012-184/2001-T.C.-IV dated 9.4.2015.

MONTHLY NATIONAL LOK ADALATS

As per directions of National Legal Services Authority and under the valuable guidance of Hon'ble the Patron-in-Chief and Hon'ble the Executive Chairman, Uttarakhand State Legal Services Authority, two monthly National Lok Adalats were organized in the various Courts of State of Uttarakhand on 14.2.2015 and 14.3.2015. Before these lok adalats, Hon'ble Executive Chairman had issued detailed guidelines through video conference to all the district legal services authorities, revenue authorities and other authorities concerned. Communications were made with various departments of the Government to make this National Lok Adalat a big success.

In the monthly National Lok Adalat held on 14.2.2015, 5629 cases u/s 138 of Negotiable Instrument Act and Recovery Suits were taken up, out of which 1492 cases were disposed of and an amount to the tune of Rs. 7,53,42,396/- was settled. On 14.3.2015, 2205 cases related to Revenue, MNREGA, Land Acquisition Act matters were taken up, out of them 1653 cases were disposed and an amount of Rs. 5,18,13,214/- was settled.

LEGAL AWARENESS CAMPAIGN THROUGH MOBILE VAN

To provide legal aid and advice at the doorsteps, legal awareness and sensitization camps were organized through mobile van in districts Tehri Garhwal, Almora and Chamoli during the period from January, 2015 to March, 2015. In the said camps documentary films on the subjects of mediation, lok adalat and legal aid prepared by National Legal Services Authority and State Legal Services Authority were displayed to the common people. The queries raised by the villagers were also solved in these camps.

During this period, State Legal Services Authority's mobile van covered 73 villages of the aforesaid districts and 5190 persons were benefited.

During the aforesaid visits of mobile van, one Mobile Lok Adalat in each district (total three in number) was also conducted, wherein 23 cases were referred, 5 cases were settled amicably and Rs. 5,000/- was realized as fine and 8 persons were benefited.

LEGAL AWARENESS AND SENSITIZATION ACTIVITIES AT DISTRICTS LEVEL

On the subjects like Female Foeticide, Women Rights and Rehabilitation of Disaster Victims, a total number of 43 camps were organized at various Villages, Tehsils, Blocks, Schools/Colleges, Hospitals and Primary Health Centres wherein 9972 persons from different strata of society were benefited.

53 micro/mega/special legal awareness camps were organized at different places whereby 14,330 persons were benefited by getting information on the subjects relating to Lok Adalat, Welfare Scheme of Central and State Government, activities/schemes of legal services institutions as well as provisions of general laws pertaining to day to day life of common people.

At schools level, 22 legal awareness camps were organized on the subject of 'Fundamental Duties' wherein 4385 students were made aware about their fundamental rights and duties. Students were also informed about various provisions of law, such as Right to Information Act, Right to Education Act, Consumer Protection Act, Domestic Violence Act and on emerging subjects like Protection/Preservation of Forest, Child Marriage and the schemes of legal services institutions.

In coordination with National Cadet Corp/National Service Scheme, 06 special legal literacy camps were organized wherein 1101 cadets participated. To aware the maximum number of people about their legal rights, need for coordination between legal services institutions and the NCC/NSS was felt on the occasion.

For the workers from unorganised sectors, 05 special legal awareness camps were organized wherein 690 workers were informed about their legal rights and the schemes for their welfare.

Beside this, 25 visits were also made to the various Jails, Judicial Lockups, Government Observation Homes, Children Homes, Protection Homes and Nari Niketans so as to assess the conditions and facilities available at these homes. Necessary suggestions were also issued to all the stakeholders of these homes.

'International Woman's Day' was also observed by conducting 11 legal awareness camps/street plays and meetings wherein 2224 females were sensitised about their legal rights and the provisions of laws relating to them.
