NATIONAL LOK ADALATS



As per directions of National Legal Services Authority and under the valuable guidance of Hon'ble the Executive Chairman, Uttarakhand State Legal Services Authority, a National Lok Adalat was organized in the State of Uttarakhand from Tehsil Level to District Level in all the Courts and Quasi Judicial Authorities on 11.02.2017. In the said National Lok Adalat, apart from the civil and criminal cases, the matters pertaining to labour disputes, revenue disputes, land acquisition act, MNREGS disputes, disaster compensation, water and electricity and all such matters which can be disposed of by way of settlement were taken up.

A total number of 28,887 cases were listed in the National Lok Adalat. Out of the said cases, 2,934 cases were disposed of through amicable settlement. Amount to the tune of `7,86,51,797/- was also settled.

ACHIEVEMENTS OF DLSAs



Success Story No. 1

किराया / बेदखली वाद

रैन्ट अपील संख्या 10 / 2016 इस्लाम बक्श आदि बनाम मौ० हसीन — यह रैन्ट अपील अल्मोड़ा न्यायालय में दिनांक 13—12—2016 से लम्बित थी। यह अपील, अपीलार्थी द्वारा विहित प्राधिकारी / सिविल जज, (सी०डि०) अल्मोड़ा द्वारा रैन्ट वाद संख्या 05 / 2015 मौ० हसीन बनाम इस्लाम बक्श आदि में बेदखली प्रार्थना पत्र पर पारित निर्णय दिनांक 11—11—2016 से क्षुब्ध होकर प्रस्तुत की गयी थी। उक्त मामला मकान मालिक व किरायेदार संबंधित था।

अतैव अपील में न्यायालय द्वारा पक्षकारों के हितों का सर्वोपरी मानते हुए, और सुलह की सम्भावना को पाते हुए, मामले में सुलह के सार्थक प्रयास किये गये तथा दिनांक 11–02–2017 को आयोजित होने वाली राष्ट्रीय लोक अदालत हेतु की गयी प्री–मीटिंग दिनांक 07–02–2017 को पक्षकारों के मध्य सुलहवार्ता करायी गयी।

पक्षकार मामले को सुलह समझौते के आधार पर निस्तारित हेतु सहमत हुए तथा मामले को राष्ट्रीय लोक अदालत में दिनांक 11—02—2017 को नियत किया गया। पक्षकारों के मध्य राष्ट्रीय लोक अदालत में विचार विमर्श व सुलहवार्ता करायी। पक्षकारान स्वैच्छा से इस बात पर सहमत हुए कि किरायेदार आज से 6 माह के अन्दर प्रश्नगत दुकान का खाली कर कब्जा मकान मालिक को दे देगा। इस प्रकार इस मामले का सौहार्दपूर्ण निस्तारण नियत राष्ट्रीय लोक अदालत में दिनांक 11—02—2017 में सफलतापूर्वक किया गया। उभयपक्ष मध्य कोई विवाद शेष नहीं रहा और उनकी रजामन्दी से मामले का अन्तिम रूप से निस्तारण कर दिया गया।

Success Story No. 2

CIVIL DISPUTE

- 1. A Civil Suit was instituted in the Court of Civil Judge (Jr. Div.), Dehradun on 21st of September, 2006 seeking permanent prohibitory injunction titled as Sushil Kumar vs. Kasturi Uniyal OS No. 50/2006
- 2. In the afore-mentioned case, there was dispute regarding the right to way between the parties.
- 3. Due to the absence of the defendants, the present Civil Suit was decreed in favour of the plaintiff. Later on the said ex-parte decree was set aside on 06th of May, 2015.
- 4. Both parties were vehemently pressing for their right to way over disputed property.
- 5. The Court of II Additional Civil Judge (J.D.), Dehradun referred the afore-mentioned case to the Lok Adalat, scheduled to be organized on 11th of February, 2017.
- 6. The Case was taken up by the Lok Adalat bench, which persuaded both parties to settle their disputes amicably.
- 7. Due to the strenuous efforts of the members of Lok Adalat bench, the parties to the Civil Suit arrived at compromise.
- 8. Both parties agreed to use the disputed way jointly in future and not to encroach over the disputed way. consequently, the dispute, which was pending between the parties since year 2006, resolved amicably. The Lok Adalat was proved beneficial to the parties litigating in the courts for last 11 years and their dispute was finally and fully settled in the said Lok Adalat by the concrete efforts made by the Bench and cooperation fo the parties.

Success Story No. 3

MATRIMONIAL DISPUTE

- 1. This Matrimonial case was instituted in the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Dehradun, by Mrs. X against Mr. Y. seeking her maintenance Under Section 125 Code of Criminal procedure, 1973.
- 2. The Marriage of Mrs. X was solemnized with Mr. Y on 24th of November, 2012 according to Hindu rituals in Mussoorie.
- 3. The couple started living happily. Meanwhile, Mrs. X became pregnant. Gradually, the relationship between the couple got strained. It was alleged that Mr. Y and his family started making demand of dowry and Mr. Y left his wife to her maternal home and never inquired about her well-being during pregnancy.
- 4. Mrs. X gave birth to a son later. But the relationships between the parties never improved. Fearing her life in danger, Mrs. X left her matrimonial home.
- 5. Mrs. X filed a case in the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Dehradun for maintenance of herself and her son. Mr. Y. did not turn up in the Court on due dates. Consequently, the Family Court passed an Order granting Rs. 600/- per month as interim Maintenance to Mrs. X and her son.
- 6. Feeling aggrieved by the Order of Principal Judge, Family Court, Dehradun, Mr. Y challenged the said Order in interim Maintenance before the Hon'ble High Court of Uttarakhand. Hon'ble Court modified the Order of Principal Judge, Family Court, Dehradun.
- 7. There after, the case was referred to the Lok Adalat, scheduled to be organized on 11th of February, 2017.
- 8. The case was taken up by the Lok Adalat bench, which persuaded both parties to settle their disputes amicably.
- 9. Due to the strenuous efforts of the members of Lok Adalat bench, the parties to the dispute arrived at compromise.
- 10. Both parties agreed to live happily together in future. They resolved that they will strive to maintain good relationship. The family went happily together after this amicable settlement.
- 11. There by, the efforts of Lok Adalat proved to be a boon for a family, which could have been broken in the absence of such powerful alternative dispute resolution system namely Lok Adalat.
