APPOINTMENT OF NEW EXECUTIVE CHAIRMAN

The Hon'ble Mr. Justice B. S. Verma, Senior Judge, High Court of Uttarakhand has assumed the charge of Executive Chairman, Uttarakhand State Legal Services Authority, Nainital w.e.f. 30.09.2013 in pursuance of the Notification No. 316/XXXVI(1)/2013-184/2001-T.C.-II dated 30.09.2013.

MEGA LOK ADALATS, LOK ADALATS & LEGAL LITERACY/LEGAL AID CAMPS

Under the valuable guidance of Hon'ble the Patron-in-Chief and Hon'ble the Executive Chairman, Uttarakhand State Legal Services Authority, Mega Lok Adalats as well as monthly Lok Adalats in all the 13 districts of the State, under the aegis of all the District Legal Services Authorities, are being organized.

MEGA LOK ADALAT

In the Mega Lok Adalats held between the months of July 2013 and September 2013 in all the 13 districts, the matters relating to MACT cases, Matrimonial cases, Revenue cases, Excise cases and cases relating to N.I. Act etc. were taken up. In these Mega Lok Adalats, a total number of **8100** cases of various nature were decided. A sum of Rs. **1,15,00,161/-** was awarded as compensation to the victims of Motor Accident and fine to the tune of Rs. **25,16,180/-** was realized towards petty offences, wherein a total number of **8324** persons were benefited.

LOK ADALAT

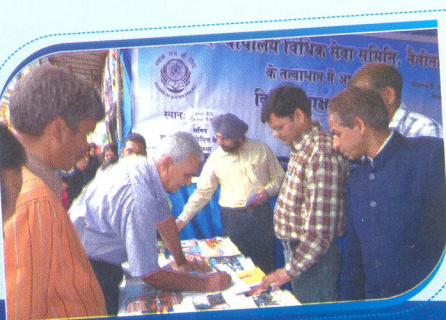
In the Lok Adalats held in the months of July, August and September 2013 in all the 13 districts, a total number of **3204** cases were settled and a sum of Rs. **64,32,313/-** was awarded as compensation and a fine to the tune of Rs. **23,29,775/-** was realized. In the said Lok Adalats, **3292** persons were benefited.

In addition to this, a total number of **56** legal literacy camps were organized in all the 13 districts of the State during July to September 2013 and **17,571** persons were benefited in the said camps. Total **200** persons were provided legal aid and **146** persons were given legal advice. In these camps, people were made aware about the aim of legal literacy camps, free legal aid and they were also informed about the general laws, such as criminal law, revenue law, right to information act, right to education and law relating to protection of women, children etc.

Beside this, special seminars were organized for women, children, un-organized workers, health workers, NCC and NSS cadets, persons of transgender community, mentally ill persons and marginalized sections of the society. In these seminars, issues, such as PC&PNDT Act, Juvenile issues, laws relating to unorganized labours, forest laws etc. are discussed.

ACTIVITIES ON LEGAL LITERACY AND AWARENESS

In order to propagate legal awareness and to make the public aware about the legal aid services and activities of legal services authorities, the Uttarakhand State Legal Services Authority put up a stall during the 'Harela Mela' at Bhimtal from 16.7.2013 to 21.7.2013. The Member Secretary, Uttarakhand State Legal Services Authority was present in the said stall. A total number of **1172** persons visited the said stall and a total number of **51,568** books of Saral Kanooni Gyan Mala series, **3750** pamphlets and application form for free legal aid were distributed to the public. Beside this, **125** sets of G.O.s pertaining to the rights and the welfare of disaster victims were also distributed.

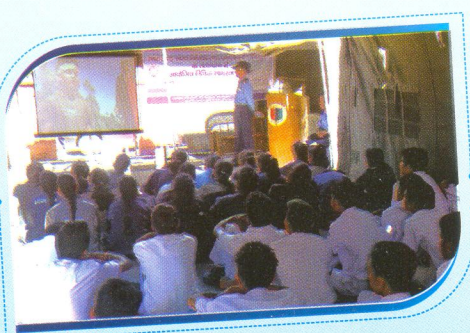
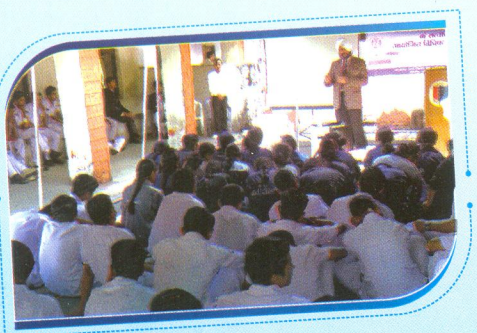


Uttarakhand State Legal Services Authority in coordination with High Court Legal Services Committee, Nainital installed a stall at Flat Ground, Nainital from 13.9.2012 to 18.9.2012. Hon'ble Mr. Justice B.S. Verma (now the Hon'ble Executive Chairman, Uttarakhand State Legal Services Authority), Member Secretary, Uttarakhand State Legal Services Authority, Registrar General and other Registrars of the Hon'ble High Court visited the said stall. Hon'ble Mr. Justice B.S. Verma distributed the sets of booklets namely 'Saral Kanooni Gyan Mala' to the people visited the stall and they were informed about the importance of the said booklets, as they provide basic information about various subjects of law. The documentary films and nukkad natak prepared by Uttarakhand State Legal Services Authority on subjects of mediation, lok adalat and legal aid and advice were also displayed to the public at large and they appreciated the same.



During the aforesaid 'Nandastami Mela', a total number of **5,228** persons visited the stall and a total number of **2,45,716** books of Saral Kanooni Gyan Mala series including pamphlets and brochures were distributed to the people.

The Uttarakhand State Legal Services Authority, Nainital in coordination with National Cadet Corps, also organized one day Legal Literacy & Sensitization Camp on 23.09.2012 at Ratighat, District-Nainital, during the occasion of Annual Training Programme conducted by the Naval Unit, National Cadet Corps, Nainital. In the said camp, Sri Kuldeep Singh Dhillon, Capt. (IN), Commanding Officer, Naval Unit, National Cadet Corps, Nainital and **275** cadets were present. A guest lecture was delivered by Sri Kanwar Amninder Singh, Member Secretary, Uttarakhand State Legal Services Authority, Nainital. The Cadets were informed about legal services mechanism and legal aid, legal literacy and awareness activities being conducted by Legal Services Authorities and were also apprised of the general laws. For making the people aware about their legal rights and for providing the social justice to the common masses, need of the coordination between Legal Services Authorities and the National Cadet Corps was also highlighted. An emphasis has also been made for organizing such types of camps regularly, so that the services of NCC Cadets may be used in sensitizing the society about their legal rights and social justice may be done. Beside this, documentary films on issues pertaining to consumer laws and legal aid and advice was also displayed to the cadets. On the said occasion, **1,150** Saral Kanooni Gyan Mala booklets were distributed to the cadets.



On 7.7.2013 District Legal Services Authority, Almora organized a legal literacy and sensitization camp at Shishu Bal Sadan, Almora. In the said camp, information was provided regarding legal rights of children and the welfare schemes being run by the Government for children. The District Judge and other Judicial Officers inspected Shishu Bal Sadan and also issued necessary directions to the officers/officials so as to resolve the problems being faced by the children at the Centre.

On 26.8.2013, District Legal Services Authority, Almora organized a jail camp at Combined District Jail, Almora/Bageshwar. In the said camp, information was provided to the prisoners regarding procedures for bail, remand and free legal aid. They were also made aware about their legal rights.



District Legal Services Authority, Almora conducted a legal literacy and sensitization camp at Chaubatia on 1.9.2013 wherein people were informed about the objects, legal aid scheme and activities of the legal services authorities. They were also informed about various subjects of law, such as legal rights of under-trial prisoners, child rights, domestic violence, lodging of F.I.R., arrest, warrant and the laws relating to wildlife. Saral Kanooni Gyan Mala books were also distributed to the people.

The District Legal Services Authority, Almora conducted a special training camp for Child Welfare Officers and Investigating Officers on 6.9.2013 at the office of Superintendent of Police. In the said training camp, Child Welfare Officers and Investigating Officers were informed about the juveniles and the provisions and procedures pertaining to Juvenile Justice Act. They were also guided about the difficulties being faced during the investigation. Necessary directions were also issued to them so as to investigate the matters relating to juveniles in a proper manner.



District Legal Services Authority, Almora put up a stall on 14.9.2013 and 15.9.2013 at the premises of Nandadevi Mahotsva wherein information on various subjects of law, such as motor accident claims, dowry, compensation, F.I.R., Consumer Protection Act and Child Marriage Act was given to the people. A large number of people visited the stall and were benefitted.



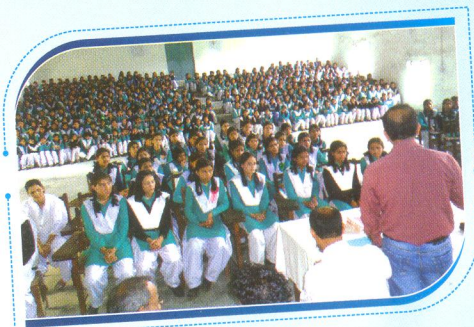
On 22.9.2013, District Legal Services Authority, Almora conducted a special legal literacy and sensitization camp for the workers in the unorganized sector at Pandeykhola wherein workers were informed about their legal rights and the provisions pertaining to Labour Laws, Industrial Disputes, and Child Labour Act.

District Legal Services Authority, Bageshwar conducted a legal literacy and sensitization camp on 21.7.2013 at Government Girls Inter College, Bageshwar. In the said camp Judicial Officers, representative of District Bar Association and Principal and Teachers of the school were present. Information pertaining to Dowry provisions, Child Marriage Act, N.D.P.S. Act, Right to Education, Copying Act, PC&PNDT Act, Lok Adalat and objects for organizing legal literacy camps was given to the students. They were also made aware about issues pertaining to early marriage and child trafficking. In the said camp, 200 students were benefitted.

District Legal Services Authority, Bageshwar organized a legal literacy and sensitization camp on 13.9.2013 at Maa Kot Bramari Temple, Garur. In the said camp, Judicial Officers, Member of Legislative Assembly, officers of district administration and large number of people were present. In the said camp, focus was made to aware the people about legal issues. They were also informed about their legal rights. A total number of **1300** persons were benefitted.

District Legal Services Authority, Chamoli conducted a legal literacy and medical camp at Government Inter College, Vikasnagar (Ghat) on 20.10.2013. In the said camp, people were informed about the objects for conducting legal literacy and sensitization camps and activities being carried out by the Legal Services Authorities. People were also made aware of their legal rights and the laws relating to PC&PNDT Act, Domestic Violence Act, Wild Life Act, M.A.C.T Act. In the said camp, medical check up of **148** persons was done and they were also distributed medicines free of cost.

On 13.7.2013 and 21.7.2013 District Legal Services Authority, Champawat conducted two legal literacy and sensitization camps at Government Girls Inter College, Tanakpur. In the said camp, students were informed about the issues relating to anti ragging and welfare schemes for the mentally ill and handicapped persons. **495** students were present in the said camp.



The District Legal Services Authority, Champawat organized a legal literacy and sensitization camp on 18.8.2013 at Block Office, Barakot. In the said camp, Judicial Officers, Chairman, District Bar Association, Superintendent of Police, Advocates and public at large were present. Gathering was informed about the free legal aid and advice being provided by the legal services authorities. They were also made aware of the important issues, such as Right to Education, Pension schemes for widows and old persons, motor accidental claims, schemes of NALSA for poor, physically handicapped and senior citizen. In the said camp, the Medical Department and Social Welfare Department also participated. Free check-up of ill persons was done and medicines were also provided to them. The Social Welfare Department also informed the people about various welfare schemes being run by the State Government. Pension forms of various persons were also filled up in the said camp.

District Legal Services Authority, Champawat on 4.8.2013 organized a special legal literacy and sensitization camp on the subjects Child Marriage and Environment Conservation at Universal Inter College, Champawat wherein people were informed about the provisions of Child Marriage Act and the difficulties caused by early marriage. They were also sensitized about the environmental issues. A drawing competition was also conducted and the participants were distributed awards.



The District Legal Services Authority, Champawat conducted a special training camp for Child Welfare Officers and Investigating Officers on 22.9.2013. In the said training camp, Child Welfare Officers and Investigating Officers were apprised about the juveniles and the provisions and procedures pertaining to Juvenile Justice Act.



On 31.9.2013, the District Legal Services Authority, Champawat organized a special legal literacy and sensitization camp at Government Girls Inter College, Champawat on anti ragging. In the said camp, students were informed about the provisions relating to Anti Ragging Act and M.V. Act. They were also informed about the guidelines issued by U.G.C. and the directions issued Hon'ble Supreme Court of India as regards anti ragging.



District Legal Services Authority, Champawat conducted a legal literacy and sensitization camp at Devidhura on the occasion of Maa Barahi Dham Bagwal Mela on 21.8.2013. In the said camp, people were informed about the objects, activities and schemes of the legal services authorities. A large number of people from remote and far flung areas visited the stall and Saral Kanooni Gyan Mala books prepared by Uttarakhand State Legal Services Authority were also distributed to the people.



On 22.9.2013, District Legal Services Authority, Champawat conducted a legal literacy and sensitization camp at Judicial Lock-up, Lohaghat. In the said camps, prisoners were informed about their legal rights and the free legal aid being provided to them by the Legal Services Authorities.

The District Legal Services Authority, Dehradun conducted a legal literacy and sensitization camp on 13.7.2013 at Govt. Girls Higher Secondary College, Shamshergarh. The District Judge and Advocates informed the students about the laws relating to Right to Information, Right to Education, Hindu Marriage Act and Domestic Violence Act.

On 7.7.2013 the District Legal Services Authority, Dehradun organized a legal literacy and sensitization camp at Kedarpuram, Defence Colony wherein local people as well as public representatives were present. In the said camp, information pertaining to various subjects of law was provided and the grievances of the people were also redressed. A total **300** persons were benefitted.

On 22.7.2013 and 23.7.2013 the Government Girls Inter College, Ranipokhari in coordination with the District Legal Services Authority, Dehradun conducted a legal literacy and sensitization camp. In the said camp, students were informed about the objects and functions of legal services authorities and the issues relating to Anti Ragging, Right to Education, Women Rights, Constitutional Rights and the fundamental duties. They were also informed about the important helplines for the safety of girl students.

The District Legal Services Authority, Dehradun in association with Medical Department and Social Welfare Department organized a legal literacy and medical camp on 13.9.2013 at Indira Colony, Mussorie. In the said camp, people were informed about the objects and activities of Legal Services Authorities and the provisions pertaining to Domestic Violence Act and M.A.C.T. Act. They were also made aware of lok adalat, mega lok adalat and eligibility criteria for availing the free legal aid and advice. The Social Welfare Department informed the gathering about the welfare schemes being run by the Government.

On 30.9.2013 District Legal Services Authority, Dehradun conducted a legal literacy and sensitization camp on the eve of 'Legal Literacy Day' at Punjab Sind Kshetra Inter College, Rishikesh. In the said camp, information on various subjects, such as fundamental rights and duties, anti ragging, child labour, protection of public property, provision pertaining to Motor Vehicle Act, Dowry and Domestic Violence Act, Right to Information Act etc. was provided to the general public.

On 25.7.2013, District Legal Services Authority, Haridwar conducted a legal literacy and sensitization camp at K.V. Inter College, Laksar. In the said camps **350** students as well as persons were present. They were informed about the provisions relating to Child Marriage Act.

District Legal Services Authority, Haridwar organized a legal literacy and sensitization camp and medical health camp on 29.9.2013 at Laldhang. People were informed about various laws relating to forest, labour, juveniles, revenue and criminal laws, mediation, lok adalat and pre-litigation lok adalats. In the said camp, **510** people were benefitted.

On 31.8.2013, District Legal Services Authority, Haridwar organized a legal literacy and sensitization camp on the issues pertaining to PC&PNDT Act at the premises of office of Chief Medical Officer, Roshnabad. In the said camp people were made aware of the provisions relating to PC&PNDT Act.

District Legal Services Authority, Haridwar conducted a special camp for the persons belonging to Schedule Caste/Schedule Tribe community on 29.9.2013 at Village-Sikandpur. In the said camp, **298** people were present. They were informed about the laws and welfare schemes pertaining to Schedule Caste/Schedule Tribe community. They were also told about the free legal aid being provided to them by the Legal Services Authorities.

On 29.9.2013 District Legal Services Authority, Haridwar conducted a legal literacy and sensitization camp at Sub Jail, Roorkee. In the said camp, **150** prisoners were present. The under-trial prisoners were informed about their legal rights and free legal aid being provided to them by the Legal Services Authorities.

The District Legal Services Authority, Nainital organized a legal literacy and sensitization camp at Government Post Graduate Degree College, Ramnagar on 29.8.2013. In the said camp, **200** female students were present and they were informed about the provisions relating to women rights.

On 30.8.2013, District Legal Services Authority, Nainital organized a legal literacy and sensitization camp at G.P.P. Girls Inter College, Ramnagar. In the said camp, **300** students were present and they were sensitized about the issue pertaining to anti ragging.

On 22.9.2013, District Legal Services Authority, Nainital conducted a legal literacy and sensitization camp at I.T.I., Maldhan Chaur. In the said camp, people were informed about the constitutional rights, fundamental rights, procedure for lodging the F.I.R., female foeticide, compensation and the provisions pertaining to UPZA&LR Act.



The District Legal Services Authority, Pauri Garhwal in association with Health Department conducted a special seminar at District Hospital, Pauri on 10.7.2013. In the said seminar, judicial officers, doctors, advocates and staff of the medical department were present. The gathering was informed about the provisions relating to PC&PNDT Act. Concern was also made on female foeticide.

The District Legal Services Authority, Pithoragarh conducted a special seminar on Child Marriage at Government Mahakali Inter College, Gangolihat on 25.7.2013. In the said seminar, students were informed about the provisions relating to Child Marriage Act and also made aware about the difficulties caused by the early marriage. A need to spread awareness against the child marriage was also highlighted.

On 17.8.2013, District Legal Services Authority, Pithoragarh organized a legal literacy and sensitization camp at Government Inter College, Didihat. In the said camp, teachers and students were informed about the provisions relating to Child Marriage Act. They were also asked to spread awareness against the child marriage.

The District Legal Services Authority, Pithoragarh conducted a special training camp for Child Welfare Officers and Investigating Officers on 25.8.2013 at District Court compound. In the said training camp, Child Welfare Officers and Investigating Officers were informed about the provisions and procedures pertaining to Juvenile Justice Act. They were also informed about their duties while investigating the matters pertaining to juveniles. The queries made by the Child Welfare Officers and Investigating Officers on the subject were also duly answered.

On 25.9.2013 District Legal Services Authority, Pithoragarh organized a legal literacy and sensitization camp at Judicial Lock-up, Pithoragarh wherein prisoners were informed about their legal rights and necessary legal aid was also provided to them. The provisions pertaining to Wildlife Act, Arrest and Bail were also told to them.



In order to make aware the doctors and other staff about the PC&PNDT Act, the District Legal Services Authority, Rudraprayag conducted a seminar at District Hospital, Gholteer on 21.7.2013. In the said seminar, provisions relating to PC&PNDT Act and Child Marriage Act were informed to the gathering. Concern was made in female foeticide and decline of child sex ratio. In the said seminar Doctors, Medical Staff, **350** people and Asha workers were present and they were also provided Saral Kanooni Gyan Mala books.



District Legal Services Authority, Rudraprayag conducted a legal literacy and sensitization camp at Village-Jasoli on 25.8.2013. In the said camp, **350** persons were present. Information pertaining to provisions of Right to Information, M.A.C.T. Act, Legal Services Authorities Act and Public Property Act was given.

On 22.9.2013, District Legal Services Authority, Rudraprayag organized a special legal literacy and sensitization camp for the persons affected by the natural calamity at Government Inter College, Augustyamuni. In the said camp, Judicial Officer, representatives of district administration and **200** affected persons were present. In the said camp, **54** complaints were also received. The District Magistrate was directed to redress the grievance of the affected persons.



On 31.7.2013, the District Legal Services Authority, Tehri Garhwal organized a legal literacy and sensitization camp at District Jail, New Tehri wherein prisoners were informed about their legal rights, procedure for bail, remand, parole, women rights, plea bargaining and free legal aid. In the said camp, **108** prisoners were benefitted.



The District Legal Services Authority, Udham Singh Nagar in association with Lions Club organized a legal literacy and sensitization camp at Daffodil Public School on 18.8.2013. In the said camp, Judicial Officer, members of Bar Association and representatives of Lions Club, teachers and students were present. People were informed about their legal rights and duties. They were also informed about the labour laws, accident claims, provisions relating to corruption and domestic violence.

On 20.8.2013, District Legal Services Authority, Udham Singh Nagar conducted a legal literacy and sensitization camp at Nai Basti, Tanakpur wherein information pertaining to women rights, child rights and their safety was given to the people. In the said camp, **180** persons were benefitted. On 31.8.2013, District Legal Services Authority, Udham Singh Nagar also organized a legal literacy and sensitization camp on Anti Ragging at Government Degree College, Tanakpur wherein students were apprised of the provisions relating to anti ragging.

The District Legal Services Authority, Udham Singh Nagar organized a legal literacy and sensitization camp on issues pertaining to PC&PNDT Act at Shahid Bhagat Singh Government Post Graduate College, Rudrapur on 29.8.2013. In the said camp, doctors, nurses, medical staff and students were apprised of the provisions of PC&PNDT Act and they were asked to spread awareness against female foeticide and decrease in child sex ratio.



On 7.7.2013, District Legal Services Authority, Uttarkashi conducted a special legal literacy camps for flood affected persons at Sri Bhuvneshwari Mahila Ashram, Joshipada. People were informed about their legal rights and welfare schemes for flood affected persons. The flood affected persons were issued disaster card and also provided relief items. In the said camp, **450** persons were benefitted.
